The Electricity Market in Rwanda is operated by the national utility, which is state owned and vertically integrated, and some Independent Power Producers (IPPs) participate in electricity generation market.

Unlike other energy commodities such as coal, oil and natural gas, electricity trade between countries is relatively limited as it is more technically complex and requires a direct cross-border interconnection.

The Electricity Sector Strategic Plan (ESSP) associated to the NST1 lays out how to provide electricity to all households in Rwanda by 2024. The ESSP's specifies that universal access will be achieved ...

Compared to the similar quarter in 2023, the total electricity generated in the first quarter of 2024 had
